AND	dog AND bone	Finds pages with both “dog” and “bone” (AND must be CAPITALIZED)
OR	dog OR bone	Finds pages with Either “dog” OR “bone” (OR must be CAPITALIZED)
“ “	“dog bone”	Finds pages with the exact phrase “dog bone”
-	dog -cat	Finds only pages with “dog” that have no mention of cats at all – best search ever!
*	dog*	Finds pages with all of these: dog, dogs, doggie, dogsledding, Dogbert....
~	~dog	Finds pages with dogs and synonyms: dog, puppy, canine
Define:	Define:canine	When you see a word you don’t know, ask what it means!
+	Learn +to Type +at Aunt Lee’s	Google disregards words like “to” “at” “on”. To make sure those words show up, put a plus + sign in front.
Site:	Site:www.auntlee.com games	Will find your search terms ONLY at that site. Helpful if you’re lost.
“B.A.T.” TIPS ON EVALUATING WEBSITES:		
		
B	Bias	Pay attention – the people who wrote the website might be trying to sell you something – either stuff or ideas. Just because it’s online doesn’t necessarily mean it’s entirely accurate.
A	Authority	Are they making it up? Do they know what they’re talking about? Look for “.edu” or “.gov” or “.org” in the URL.
T	Timeliness	Things change – look for how recently the site was updated.
