


Start	To open the program, click on the start button in the far left hand corner.
Programs	Pull up to programs and then across to Music Masterworks

4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4 4	The top half, with this S looking symbol, is called the Treble Clef it's where higher notes go.
9 : 4	The bottom half, with the backwards C looking thing, is called the Bass Clef - it's where the lower notes go.





	Create a whole note With the note still highlighted, find the letter "c" on your keyboard. Click it once.
	The first time you click it, it puts other notes on the staff for you - this forms what's called a Chord.
3 4 4 7 7 7 7 7 7 7 7 7 7 7 7 7 7 7 7 7	Hit the space bar to play those few notes and hear what the chord sounds like. Try different chords by clicking the letter "c" again and again, and playing those.
	Remember, you can click on any note to choose it and try out some chords - you're the composer, so experiment until you find what you like.
