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
BE A MOVIE MAKER!

		We're going to use the free program Windows Movie Maker to learn about frame-by-frame animation.
		We're going to become movie directors - we'll create our actors out of clay, create a story, do our own camera work and then do post-production work in Windows Movie Maker.
Tips: • •	Keep shapes simple Keep action to 20 frames or fewer Put one object that doesn't move at the edge of the frame to use to keep the frames steady Make a lot of tiny changes between each frame to make your creations seem alive!
